My research asks which findings explain judicial decisions under multifactor legal tests. I study trademark confusion at the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board and in federal courts using computational and empirical methods. I examine what the findings mean for legal rules, litigation, and the division of decisions between judges and juries. My current research also addresses copyright fair use and patent remedies.
